I believe veryone did. I I knew you & the rest would worry and there was no sence to lif I did tell ferry about it but I told him to tell no one where I was, we left angio and went through Rome toward legharm, we didn't get there because we were

called back - when we were called buck we jest about benow where we were going and seve enough we were on the wasion of Southern France, it's nothing like angio, we did have a lifew raids, wone of them were very serious. if they came back again, which they will they'll find themselves in a lat of trouble - I'm talking about Sterman aisplanes Mon. I did see Rome and a lat of other places in Italy, but we never did get to see the best part of Stalp- the northern part. I was in Maples again and of tried to find Beno ant I hade to give up - quesa see have to wait till of get home to see Beno. I bourt seen very much of France yet but Im sure eve will before we leave here. I can't say very much about this place till I see somere of it What little I have seem look's pretty nice - prenty of their & green grass - havn't seek very worke pretty hungry as they

are. The people in Italy were hungry too, also sicily & M. Offica so I heard - but what few people Ine seen dont look very hungre to me-you have to expect things like that, some one somelwhere is going to be Sin hoping and praying this war with end soon So everyone can be home again and back on their fut once more - this I for one will frag that the soon. In feeling Gine Mon so please don't you or Dad do any warriging about me, Lin in the sestof health I may be in Southern France, but one would never know it it's so paragree here one wouldn't think their's a war on. In sure gladiets nathing like angio, I boont nong much more to write about Mon so don't expect a very long letter Boy I have on Tauful place here to write - I have fleven got a box

How's the weather allhome, fine I bet it's really swell hereeverything is green the sure both in all everything is just swell. I havrit recieded any letter's yet because of my moving and the envasion yeter - we ashould get mail soon now at least a week or two after the irasion we should get mail it will be swell to get some letter's Ill let you know about that in my next letter, Son bello to everyone for me - and remember now & don't want you ar Dad to do everything is gaing along just swell take care of everything this war can't last much longer andwhen its over Ilabe home to take up where I left off at - Soe watch & Blessover Some of Thisses four Loving Buona Motte XXX- Julie - XXX
