I had a swell time and I don't mean maybe - Mom the whole story is about these French girls' - limitiful they really are - it's a long story though so I've have to let it go for some time yet it's one good time I won't forget in some time - girle, girle, and I mean mice girle. teday was like any other day-quiet gotup latthe same time, 7:30 AM, est chow pulled a little guard, after guard I task all my blankets autside to day- we always have a pretty heavy dew whate one letter and it was time for chaw again, in the aftercasion I took a little nap which didn't last long because we had to fall out letry formation) it was a lecture on V.D. it's all stuff but some guy's never learn-till of course it's to late after the leature I would my face, made up my led, and went to draw-5:00 PM, in the evening & played estel with a footfoll and a sole a baseball our Bitiguis playing a game of baseball of with a colored outfit - so for the score is 4-3 - fovor us these colored men sure are a laugh, they don't care about anything and one always laughing. Our wail come in and I got two letter's some from from and the I still have four or Thing letters to ones up. In getting a little tied of answering letters but as long as they write to me I'll write lack of The game is over and we won again, 4-3 - very good game. We are getting passis now to a very nice town I shelive believe the name is (Hice - when my pass comes up and if I go I'll tell you all about it in my letter, its suppose to be a swell town. The dew is starting to sall and since I'm outside writing this eletter I better close for tonight so Thomas Dad- sleep tightwith all my love to heep your support Brown With that Not much of a day, we did the some thing except we did play a game of football in the evening, we won 12-0. Oh say we did have a rifle inspection - and of got caught with my pants down my rifle is abought clean, or always was tell they pulled the inspection and found the barked dirty - to top that I didn't have a shave - boy my heart droped right down to the Bottom of my feet. When the captain was through looking us over he said that everyone with dirty rifles wouth not get passed-I ever happen I don't know because I did get a pass for tomorrow to the town of Mice- which is suppose to be a wonderful place - del tellyon about that when I get back - I sure was lucky to get that pass, I was more surprised then the rest of the fellow's - and they were surprised they ever found

my rifle dirty, their was Some rust on it too. I had quarts of ail on the rifle, but this theory dever goes right UNITED STATES ARMY through all of it it was writed up to tap it off. Well din going to bed because we leave at 8:00 AM and its a long way to Mice. Goodnight everyone elect tight and til be back tomarrow night with all the Cated new's What a time I had wonderful! I'll start from the arguining and tell the whole story hong on its pretty good.

We got in town about 1130 AM and off we went to see the righte- meaning the beautiful girls. That's what we wanted to find, and a cauple of nice girls, but well get to that later on The town itself is swell, it's the see as near as being in the states fire been yet the stores are the same - pleaty of everything they have ten cent stores Tike the one's swe how at home, the same in everyway except the name, The rest of the building are very vice and clean looking - the streets are clean, the women are swell dresser, the girl' dress as good as the ones at home, if not better - and friendly Woll! after looking the town over Sine thought it was time to meet some girls - and we did, one right after the other. we went into a ice cream store pretty good ice cream) and sat with some gials to bought them ice cream and talked 4 stalked, some of them can speak a little Emplish

we got along swell with them. We left there a while later and went to a show in French. We had a time in there the girls came up and ask us to set with them they were just being nice they had their falks with them down it after the show we went back to get same more ice cream and of course to talk to the july well we did meet two more - filled them upon ice cream and talked about every thing - there two couldn't speak english But they could apak Italian, so every thing was find she was a slowd with Blue eyes - beautiful if I may say so They were both swell girl but this one had all the baks - her name was Valda - Stalian, blond with blue eyes - 100 lls - 5/2" - what a figure. WoW. 24 year's ald ( never brow it) still don't believe it. We took the two of them home bissed them goodby - I got her address and whe got our's - Said she would write which will be alright with us. We tried to take. them some place to eat they couldn't go I said couldn't because they had to get home to eat their's mathing in the whole town to eat if you do find something to eat you wouldn't have enough money to pay for it, after taking there two girls home in a bugger you know the kind a horse pulls - We went about four miles which costess every cent of it swell july, we went looking for a couple more - & found them

It was getting dark when we met them ( which was good) one of them could speak English, she had four & a Kall years of it, they were both very protty- she said "what do you want with us" in very nice English which made us very laspy to levow she could speak it, the other couldn't speak it at all she come from their the other came from Paris, Well anywayene rehal them if they would go to the show with is, they Said yes and away we went we dedn't pay any attention to the feiture - which waint very good any way, we talked about everything. It was getting close to our time of leaving This. so we had to leave in the middle of the picture, we walked them home (as you know me grow and my friend was as tall we hissel them goodby- lovely- wonderful- oh these French girls. They said to come back, we said we sure would if we could, we kissed them again for the last time and took off for the truck - sure lated to leave. we got their address and if the chance does ever come for us to go to This again - we sure will look them up - & how. We had a swell time to in town, best fire hall since I left have . I'm on H.P. the next day it's all ones at one time-maybe I'm just too good a man to let lay around the year hay Buona Hotte Suite & Soo Gless your of the State of the St well mon another day is over with, didn't do any thing very interesting, I was lating orderly today and tomarrow I'm on quard, I thought it was H. P lest I was every I didn't do any thing in the marriage except clean the latine, in the afternoon we played bootball with a calared suffet, eve won again 30-0, I feel pretty stiff now, those colored bay's were frethe down big but we won anyway - good game. tought but the ather team libral show up - we beat them defore - 30-0, I que they were agraid to come back again. It's dark outside now and nathing to do but yo to led and sleep like every ather night fin nat on gun quard tonight so I should go a get a good

night sleep, I do have to go on they quard at eight in the marning We didn't get any mail tonight but I bet me get some soon - I hape. Well mom I guess that's all their is to say for tonight, maybe I'll have more to sury tomorrow night I sure hape so. Lay hello to all, elect tight sweet O- late of love alwards -SEPT-16-1944 - SAT-I was on Bly guard all day so I couldn't do much of anything, I got up the same time, eat show and went on quar at 8:00 are got aff guard at 10:00 AM. wrote some letter's and at 12:00 I establew again. at 2:00 PM. I went bock on guard, kind of glad I was on guard today because we had a hike - at 2:00 P.M. I went on guard and they went on a like, of guess tel have to take the next onethings get nongtonous around durning the evening no shows to see, no plate to go in fact their just prison anything to do one and won the other - so what's not so bad. I didn't get any mail tonight but I'm sere haping I get some tomarrow night onswer them, Well Mon how is everything I havit augmore to say so goodright and sleep tight with all my love to keep you company - tell Post-wat to work too hard. 3 EPT- 17- 1944 - SUN-Well my guard was up at 80 clock this marring, after chow I would and showed got back from church I wrote a letter to claime's sister thelina, it was moon by the time I finished the letter, after mailing the letter and eating chow eve played a game of baseball among ourselve, just a nice friendly game - Atrained

most of the afternoon but not United States ARMY

United ralled around we played a good rough and tough game game of South football with our "C" Oty - we woon again 18-6, it was a very good game, a little rough but late of fun - all the guy's ore good sports, that what counts in any game. The game ended 15 minutes to eight, it's now 8:30 PM and very dark autide, I go on gun quard in the marning 5-6 - and that is the end of another day, week and letter, tomorrow night will stort another week and letter. I think there letter's are best because I can say more and make the letter's longer Sand maybe more interesting. My candle is about hurned out and it's the only light we have when it gets dark - send me some candle's if that I didn't get poyed again none of us have I don't really care because I brown del always get it, if ene get bayed next mouth I should get better then \$50, and all aprit will go home - I don't need it so why beef it. I had two letter's from dur angie last week, she is fine and so is everyone else she said her house is looking swell angil is really making her dream come true - now for the swiming pool and times court- HA HA-J

hope she gets every bit of it & more Well Sweetheart how are you & Dad making out is every thing gaing along albright? I weryone freling fine?
